

## ST. LOUIS METROPOLITAN POLICE DEPARTMENT Burglary Prevention Tips

- SECOND DISTRICT
- Lock all windows and doors when you leave your home, even if you will only be gone for a short time AND at night.
- Install quality **dead bolt** locks with one inch bolt lengths on each door in your home.
- Use an **alarm** and/or **camera** system. While no system will make your home 100 percent safe, a quality alarm and/or camera system can be an excellent crime deterrent.
- **Illuminate** your residence at night and regularly replace bulbs. Use timers and motion detectors if possible.



• Secure pet doors, ventilation **windows** and other entrances to your home.



- If you are going out of town, **stop** mail and newspaper deliveries or have a trusted neighbor of friend pick them up in order to avoid the appearance you are out of town.
- Don't leave spare keys in recognizable spots.
- Call police if you see any suspicious activities.
- Don't leave valuables visible to those outside your home.
- Do NOT announce your absence on voicemail, e-mail, or social media sites!
