
SAFETY COMMUNITY SAFETY OUTREACT

- Leave your **PORCH LIGHTS** on. Consider adding **MOTION LIGHTS** to the front and rear of your house/property because crime flourishes in the dark.
- Keep valuables out of sight or in the trunk of your vehicle and LOCK YOUR CAR DOOR

Park in areas with good lighting

- **NEVER** leave your car running or keys in the ignition. Keep all key fobs with you and not in the vehicle
- If your vehicle has an alarm or other anti-theft devise, use it . . . If not, consider using a car club that locks to the steering wheel column
- Alarms and glass break sensors are a great deterrent for burglars
- Consider a doorbell camera and cameras in the rear of your home (popular point of entry). The St. Louis Metropolitan Police Department has partnered with Ring on the use of the Neighbors App. Cameras can help improve and aid criminal investigations by producing digital evidence used to identify and track down suspects, and ultimately help solve crimes.
