2. ESSAY – In 150 words or less “Why I Am Deserving of This Scholarship.”

3. COMMUNITY SERVICE –List of community projects and/or any service hours that exemplify your leadership and citizenship in the community. This service should have been completed during your 8th grade year so far and **NOT** performed because of mandatory religious or school requirements (i.e. **acceptable**: volunteer opportunities in Girl Scouts not including religious awards, volunteer service benefitting the St. Louis Hills Neighborhood Association, watching neighbor's children without pay, etc.). Service is not limited to the St. Louis Hills community.

4. LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION – This could be from a teacher, clergy, neighbor, etc. Please ask the person to avoid using your name when possible in the letter (Your name will be “whited-out” on all documents before they are given to the judges.)

5. PLEASE REVIEW- Eligibility requirements included on next page, or on the *stlhills.com* website under the heading “membership and benefits.”

Please Note: Applicants' families must have a **history** of membership in the SLHNA, including 2023. Please be sure to read all Eligibility Requirements (below or on the website), before applying. Contact Toni or Steve Zychinski with any questions at thehome@yahoo.com or (314) 440-2355. Scholarship recipients will be announced at grade school graduation ceremonies when possible.

The eligibility rules are:

- The applicant must be the child/ legal dependent of a St. Louis Hills Neighborhood Association member living within the boundaries of St. Louis Hills. The applicant's family must have a recent history of membership in the SLHNA, including 2023.
- The applicant must be an 8th Grade student. The scholarship award is for the freshman year of high school only; it is non-renewable.
- The applicant may apply on their own behalf or be nominated.
- The application must be postmarked by the deadline noted on the application. The 2023 deadline is **Friday, April 14th, 2023**.
